Service status - snapshot

- Update on survey May 2020
- Is your service?
- 1. Open and staffed as normal: Physical space is open. Most LKS staff onsite.
- 2. Open and unstaffed: Physical space is accessible but not staffed. Staff working from home and services being provided virtually.
- 3. Open with minimum staffing: Physical space is accessible. One or more LKS staff onsite (e.g. on a rota) but others working from home.
- 4. Physical space not accessible. Staff working from home and services being provided virtually.
- 5. Service is routinely delivered virtually and is continuing to operate as before.

Evidence to inform a postnatal improvement plan

NHS Nottingham and Nottinghamshire CCGs approached library and knowledge specialists for assistance in obtaining a synthesis of evidence to support the development of a local Postnatal Improvement Plan.

Library and knowledge specialists undertook a rapid review and developed evidence packs to inform workshop discussions. This saved the organisation an estimated £6,500 which would have been needed to procure this support externally.


